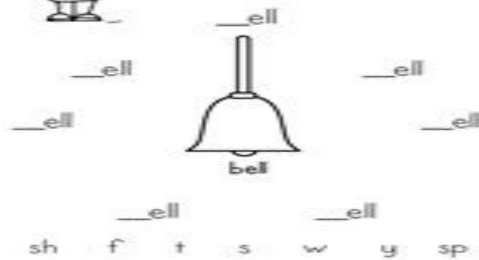
Rewrite the words below.
