Writing Equations

Converting words to numbers and operations is the first step to solving a word problem. As you look at the words in a problem, look for equals or is as your signal to add an equal sign.

EXAMPLE: Look at this sentence, written two ways: Ten plus two equals a number. Ten plus two is a number. Both sentences say the same thing: $10 + 2 = n$
