# Enlarging Artwork Using a Grid Design

During the Renaissance period artists developed a way to use grid lines to make their objects more proportioned. Below is a photograph with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " grid drawn on it. Next to it is a proportional grid drawing with a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " grid drawn on it. Look at the shapes in each box of the picture and draw the contours of those shapes larger in the same box on the larger grid. By looking at each box individually and the shapes you see in it you are breaking down the picture making it easier to draw. After you have completed the enlarged contour drawing go back and shade the picture.
