

## Sentences & Sentence Fragments

A **sentence** tells a complete thought.

It has a subject (or who or what) and a predicate (which begins with a verb).

A **sentence fragment** does not tell a complete thought.

It may be missing a subject (or who or what) and/or part of the predicate (which includes the verb).
