### Week 1

## August 2

- 1. Highs and Lows
- 2. "Me" ppt.
- 3. Go over syllabus and needs list/discuss 3 ring notebook.
- 4. Ice breaker (if time)
- 5. HW: get syllabus signed—syllabus due Friday and quiz over forms of persuasion & parts to an introduction.

#### August 3

- 1. BR: students name the forms of persuasion.
- 2. Quickly look at ppt. to review forms of persuasion.
- 3. Continue ice breaker—groups will defend their solution by using one form of persuasion in explanation. (chart paper needed)

## August 4

- BR: give sample prompt (Topic 1121 in notebook)-students will write an attention getter and a thesis statement the best they can based on last year's memory.
- 2. Introduce "The Melton Method"—give handout and discuss the parts to the intro.
- 3. Use prompt from BR and brainstorm—prewrite, pro's and con's, why? And why not?, etc...

#### August 5

- 1. BR: show students sample attention getter and thesis for this topic.
- 2. Students write their intro. Using the Melton Method.
- 3. Trade papers and peer evaluate using the method.
- 4. HW: fix/improve intro based on peer's notes.

### August 6

- Quiz on Forms of Persuasion and parts of the intro. (they will also have to write a sample intro. With a prompt I give them.)
