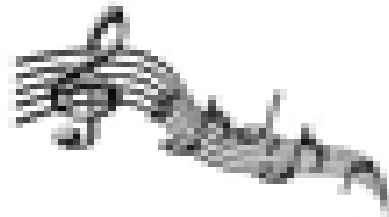


PRODUCTIVE LANGUAGE PROJECT

- 1) Simile
- 2) Metaphor
- 3) Personification
- 4) Hyperbole
- 5) Alliteration
- 6) Onomatopoeia



Directions:

STEP 1

- 1) Choose a song from each figurative language category.
- 2) Go to youtube.com and search the name of the song and singer, with the word "lyrics" for the video.
- 3) Read the lyrics as you listen to the music. Find the examples of figurative language in the song.
- 4) Choose 1 song of your own, and identify the figurative language. The lyrics and song MUST be APPROVED by me.

STEP 2

Next, put together a Power Point presentation. You will make 2 slides for each type of figurative language.

Slide 1:

- 1) You must include a title (name of the figurative language)
- 2) Define the figurative language
- 3) Identify the name of the song
- 4) Add a picture that relates to your song
- 5) Link to song on Youtube (lyrics version)
