delta

windblown sand that has formed hills in deserts and on beaches

fjord

flat or gently rolling lands

plain

a group of closely scattered islands

dune

any natural shape found on Earth's surface

plateau

long, steep-sided glacial valley now filled by seawater

cliff

large body of ice that moves across the earth's surface

mesa

flat-topped, elevated land

archipelago

triangular section of land built up at a river's mouth

glacier

high, steep or overhanging rock face

landform

flat land mass higher than the surrounding land, with at least one
