Instructions

If you want to copy information or photos from the internet, there are a few rules you need to follow. This activity was designed to help you understand copyright laws as they pertain to the internet. During your lifetime, you will use various pieces of information from the internet. It is important that you understand what is acceptable to use and how to give credit for what you use, so that you are not breaking the law.

Learner Description

This activity was intended to teach middle and high school students the copyright laws for use of information from the internet. Although it would be appropriate for any internet user.
