

6th Grade Science Syllabus
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Overview

Seventh grade science will be a fun and exciting class. Students will participate in many different types of assignments in the classroom, the hatchery and occasionally in the sound. Each student is expected to participate and get involved in activities and discussions during the class. It is the student's responsibility to complete their work and to ask the teacher for assignments missed when absent. The topics that will be covered in science this year are: geological cycles, energy and matter cycles, solar system, energy transfer and transformation, and population dynamics. The hatchery/oyster reef program is also an integral part of their science education.

Grading

The grading system will be based on a points system. Each assignment will be given a point value, depending on the amount completed and quality of work, points will be earned. The final grade will be student's total points out of total points possible for all assignments
