*Calvin and Hobbes* is a syndicated daily comic strip that was written and illustrated by American cartoonist Bill Watterson, and syndicated from November 18, 1985, to December 31, 1995. It follows the adventures of Calvin, a precocious and imaginative six-year-old boy, and Hobbes, his sentient stuffed tiger. The pair are named after Immanuel Kant, a Prussian philosopher, and Thomas Hobbes, a 17th-century English political philosopher. Nearly 47 million copies of the 13-*Calvin and Hobbes* books have been sold.

*Calvin and Hobbes* is set in the contemporary United States in an unspecified suburban area. The strip depicts Calvin's flights of fancy and his friendship with Hobbes, and also examines Calvin's relationships with family and classmates.
