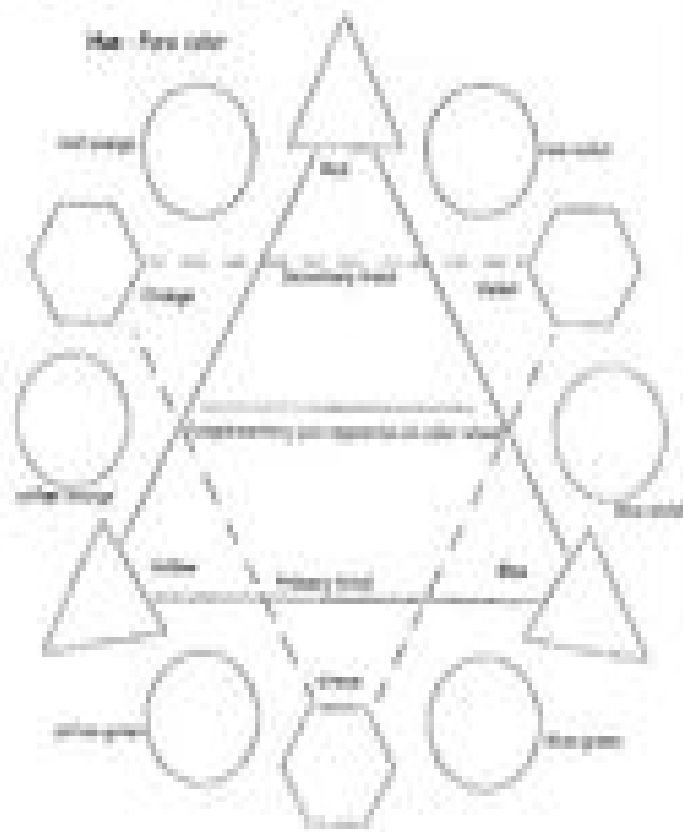


COLOR THEORY



Intensity - The brightness or darkness of a color also called its saturation

100%	50/50					100%

Value - The lightness or darkness of a color

100%	50%	100%	100%	50%	100%

Simultaneous Contrast - When one color is placed next to another

100%						100%

Primary Colors - Red, Yellow, Blue
These colors cannot be mixed from any other color

Secondary Colors - Orange, Green, and Violet
Created by mixing the equal amounts of primary colors

Intermediate (Tertiary) Colors - Purple, Red-Orange, Yellow-Green
Created by mixing the primary and secondary colors: (R, Y), (Y, B), (B, R)
