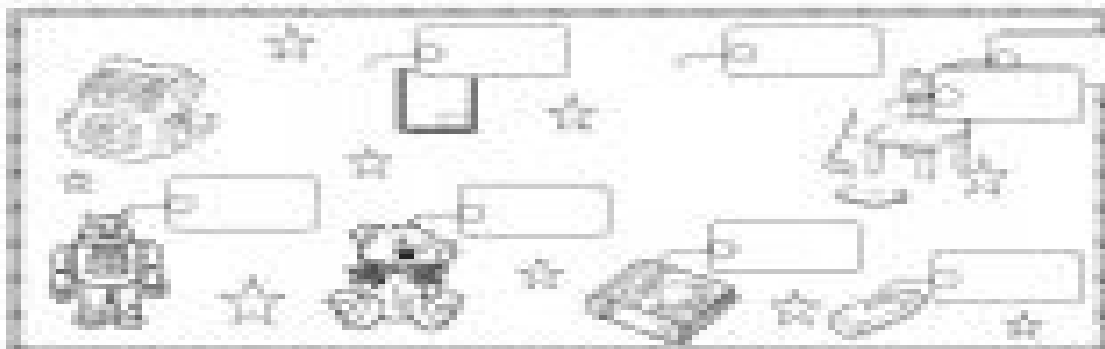


Money practice for 100p

1. Read each coin's value.



- 1p The coin is shiny and small.
- 2p The shiny coin is shiny and small.
- 5p The coin is the smallest shiny coin.
- 10p The coin is half a shilling? It's shiny and small.
- 20p The coin is shiny and small.
- 50p This coin is shiny and small.
- 100p The coin is the largest? It's shiny and small.
- 10p The note is shiny and small.

Remember
100p is 1 pound.
By the way.



2. Write the number of coins.

- 100p
- 10p
- 50p
- 20p
- 10p

For example:
100p = 100 shiny 1p coins.
10p = 10 shiny 1p coins.
50p = 50 shiny 1p coins.

- One penny "Twenty pence"
- One hundred pence "Five pence"
- Eight pence "Fifty pence"
- "Twenty pence" "Twenty pence"
