



Parallel Lines	Intersecting Lines	Perpendicular Lines
		
<p>\overleftrightarrow{AB} and \overleftrightarrow{CD} are parallel lines. They never cross, even if they are extended.</p>	<p>\overleftrightarrow{AB} and \overleftrightarrow{CD} are intersecting lines. They cross each other at point J.</p>	<p>\overleftrightarrow{AB} and \overleftrightarrow{CD} are perpendicular lines. They form right angles where they cross.</p>






