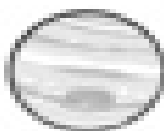
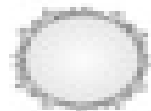


Super Sweet Solar System



Materials for each student: paper plate; compass; frosting; sugar cookie; orange, yellow, green, and red candy-coated chocolate candy; tiny rocklike candies; red, yellow, and blue dry cereal loops; small cinnamon candy; chewy circle candies

Directions:

1. Find and mark the center of the plate. Then use a compass to draw an oval that represents the planets' orbit around the sun.
2. Using frosting, stick the cookie (sun) in the center of the plate. Label it.
3. Using frosting, stick an orange chocolate candy on the plate so it represents Mercury. Label it.
4. Using frosting, stick a yellow chocolate candy to the plate so it represents Venus. Label it.
5. Using frosting, stick a green chocolate candy on the plate so it represents Earth. Label it.
6. Using frosting, attach a red chocolate candy to the plate so it represents Mars. Label it.
7. Spread a strip of frosting in the open space after Mars. Cover the frosting with the tiny rocklike candies so they represent the asteroids in the Main Belt. Label them.
8. Using frosting, stick a red cereal loop on the plate so it represents Jupiter. Label it.
9. Using frosting, stick a cinnamon candy on top of the red cereal loop.
10. Wrap a chewy loop candy around a yellow cereal loop. Then use frosting to stick them on the plate so they represent Saturn. Label it.
11. Using frosting, stick a blue cereal loop sideways on the plate so it represents Uranus. Then use icing to stick a tiny rock-like candy to the side of Uranus. Label the planet.
12. Using frosting, stick another blue cereal loop on the plate so it represents Neptune. Label it.
