Compound Sentences and Subject-Verb Agreement

A **compound sentence** has two or more simple sentences joined by a comma and a **conjunction** (*and, but, or*).

Each **subject** and **verb** pair must agree in number. A **singular** subject must have a singular verb. A **plural** subject must have a plural verb.
