<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are warm-blooded • Give live birth (or eggs) and breastfeed milk • Have a backbone (just internal skeleton) • Live out-of-water (except for some) • Have skin and fur or hair • Breath through their lungs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are cold-blooded • Lay eggs • Have a backbone (just internal skeleton) • Live out-of-water (except for some) • Have no legs • Have 6 body parts • Breath through small openings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are warm-blooded • Give live birth or lay eggs • Have a backbone (just internal skeleton) • Live in land and water • Have scales and dry skin • Have 4 short legs or no legs at all • Breath through their lungs
