

Different types of animals

<p>Amphibians</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are cold blooded • Lay eggs • Have 4 limbs (one front/back) • Live in and out of water • Do not have scales • Breathe through their skin <p>List 2 amphibians:</p>	<p>Birds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are warm blooded • Lay eggs • Have 4 limbs (one front/back) • Have wings and can usually (but not always) fly • Have feathers • Breathe through lungs <p>List 2 birds:</p>	<p>Fish</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are cold blooded • Lay eggs • Have 4 limbs (one front/back) • Live in water • Have scales • Breathe through gills <p>List 2 fish:</p>
<p>Mammals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are warm blooded • Give live birth (no eggs) and feed with milk • Have 4 limbs (one front/back) • Live out of water (except for some) • Have skin and fur or hair • Breathe through their lungs <p>List 2 mammals:</p>	<p>Insects</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are cold blooded • Lay eggs • Have 6 limbs on the outside (exoskeleton) • Live out of water (except for some) • Have six legs • Have 3 body parts • Breathe through small openings <p>List 2 insects:</p>	<p>Reptiles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are cold blooded • Give live birth or lay eggs • Have 4 limbs (one front/back) • Live in and out of water • Have scales or dry skin • Have 4 short legs or no legs at all • Breathe through their lungs <p>List 2 reptiles:</p>
