Subject Relative Clause

The lady whom I met collected pictures that were beautiful.
She performed the same work that I have to do.
I met her when she got married to a man.

Subject Relative Clause

The people whom I met were very friendly.

The people whom I met were speaking several languages.
The people whom we were visiting were very friendly.

Recently we have bought a house we are building.
Recently we have bought a house which we are building.

I met Alfred the car that he had bought last year.

Object Relative Clause

The people whom we visited were very friendly.
The people whom I met were speaking several languages.
