

How to Draw a Chinese Dragon Face

Start by drawing lightly so you can erase later.
Draw a large circle for the head and rectangles for the snout and jaw. Use circles for the eyes and nose.

Make the lines flow so there are no straight lines.

Use wavy lines for the mane so the mane looks like fire. Use heavy lines for the eye lashes and eye brow.



The collars are two wavy lines that twist. There can be one or two. Add a spout on fire.



Use triangles for the teeth and a long skinny triangle for the tongue. Don't bend back.

Add decorations like flames, scales or circles to fill in the empty spaces.

Get the ear roundness.

Go over your drawing with a fine tip marker and erase the pencil marks or trace it. Then color your dragon - use a lot of red, yellow and orange.
