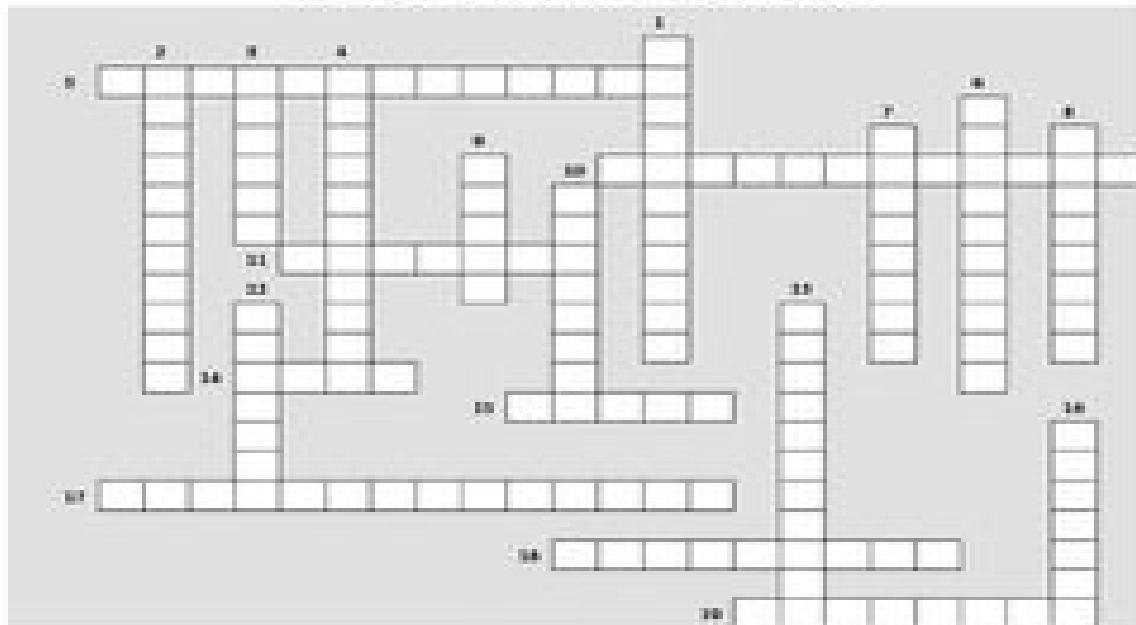


Cells & Classification
