Noun Practice

Common Noun – a person, place or thing.

examples: boy, town, school

Proper Noun – a specific person, place or thing.

examples: Tom, Atlanta, Lincoln Elementary School

Singular Noun – only one person, place or thing.

examples: toy, girl, pet

Plural Noun – more than one person, place or thing.

examples: toys, girls, pets

Possessive Noun – shows ownership.

examples: the girl's cat, Tom's ball, the school's flag
