**Possessive pronouns** take the place of **possessor's**. **My, your, his, her, its, our** and **their** are **possessive pronouns**. Their use follows the following:

**Example:**

(a) **Footless** are **white** **socks**.  
The **socks** **belong** **to** **her** **feet**.

**mine, yours, his, hers, ours, and theirs** are also **possessive pronouns**. They can stand alone, even without a noun right after.

**Example:**

The **set** **of** **crackers** **are** **yours**.  
That **is** **my** **yellow** **shirt** **is** **green**.
