Frequency Adverbs Worksheet

An adverb is a word that describes a verb, an adjective, or another adverb.
Some adverbs tell the frequency of which the action takes place.
Ex: often, never, usually, always, rarely, sometimes, often, frequently.

Place a frequency adverb in each sentence. Use the adverb in parentheses to indicate the frequency of the action.

Example: A: The students finish their homework on time. (always)

Answer: The students always finish their homework on time.
