Verb Tenses

To form the *past tense* of most verbs, add -ed.

example: jump - jump<u>ed</u>

To form the *present tense* of most verbs, add -s or -es.

examples: speak - speaks

To form the **future tense** of most verbs, add the helping verb \underline{will} before the main verb.

example: fix - <u>will</u> fix
