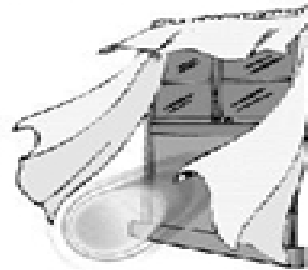


## Ball of Lightning!
