dou • ble (dub'əl) *adj.* twice as much

The entry word shows how to divide a word into syllables.

jour • ney (jēr'nē) *n.* a trip

The accent mark shows which syllable is accented.

li • ar (lī'ər) *n.* someone who does not tell the truth

The respelling shows how to pronounce the word.

pur • pose (pēr'pes) *n.* aim; intention

The part of speech is abbreviated.

sub • due (sū'dū)

Some words have more than one meaning.
