13th - thirteenth

14th - fourteenth

15th - fifteenth

16th - sixteenth

17th - seventeenth

18th - eighteenth

19th - nineteenth

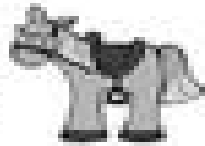
20th - twentieth

21st - twenty-first

22nd - twenty-second

23rd - twenty-third

24th - twenty-fourth
