# Ordinal Numbers

We use ORDINAL NUMBERS to tell the position of people or things that are in order.

1<sup>st</sup> – first

7<sup>th</sup> – seventh

13<sup>th</sup> – thirteenth

19<sup>th</sup> – nineteenth

2<sup>nd</sup> – second

8<sup>th</sup> – eighth

14<sup>th</sup> – fourteenth

20<sup>th</sup> – twentieth

3<sup>rd</sup> – third

9<sup>th</sup> – ninth

15<sup>th</sup> – fifteenth

21<sup>st</sup> – twenty-first

4<sup>th</sup> – fourth

10<sup>th</sup> – tenth

16<sup>th</sup> – sixteenth

22<sup>nd</sup> – twenty-second

5<sup>th</sup> – fifth

11<sup>th</sup> – eleventh

17<sup>th</sup> – seventeenth



23<sup>rd</sup> – twenty-third
