



## Creating a Canyon

The Grand Canyon is in Arizona. It is 277 miles long, up to 18 miles wide, and more than one mile deep. Cars cannot drive to the bottom of the canyon. The only way down is to walk or ride a mule. The temperature at the bottom of the canyon can be 26 degrees hotter than at the top.

Erosion began forming the Grand Canyon millions of years ago. The Colorado River carried rocks and soil that wore away the land and created the canyon. Many layers of rock line the canyon walls. The layers are different colors. At sunset, the rock layers seem to glow.
