Directions: Choose a <u>different activity each night</u>, <u>Monday through Thursday</u>, for your spelling and vocabulary homework. <u>Make sure your words are spelled correctly and take the time to sound out each one</u>. You will turn in some kind of proof of homework each morning (practice sheets, parent signed notes, etc.). Please date your work. Your spelling and vocabulary tests will be on Friday.

 ABC Order Write all of your spelling words in alphabetical (ABC) order. 	Word Parts Write all your words. Then use a colored pencil to divide the words into syllables.	3. Telephone Spelling Use the telephone to find the value of half of your spelling words. Example: button = 38 (2+8+8+8+6+6)	4. Silly Sentences Write 10 sentences that use 10 of your spelling words.
5. Picture words Draw a picture and hide 10 of your spelling words in the picture.	6. Shape Words (8) sp spe spe spell spelli spellin spelling (or make them boot shaped, wagon shaped, smiley face, etc.)	7."Ransom" Words "Write" 8 of your words by cutting letters out of a newspaper or magazine and gluing the letters on a piece of paper to spell your words.	8. Rainbow Words Write all your spelling words with colored pencils. Make each letter a different color.
9. Scrambled Words Write all your words once. Then write all of them again (once) with the letters mixed up. (Try giving it to a classmate to see if he or she can figure them out)	10. Vowel Spotlight Write all your words using one color for the vowels and another color for the consonants. (vowels: a, e, i, o, u)	11. Scrabble Write spelling words crisscross using a common letter. Example: desert i alarm acorn e	12. Word Search Create your own word search with your spelling. Show the answers to your puzzle. This counts for two day's work. Or you can create and print out your word search from puzzlemaker.com
