Include details about your character's appearance and personality.</p>	<p><b>Create a story bag!</b>            Draw and summarize the story elements of your story: 1 picture and 1 sentence for each element: plot, characters, problems, resolution, setting, write the title and reflect on the bag and describe.</p>	<p><b>Make a shadow!</b>            Draw and summarize the story elements of your story: 1 picture and 1 sentence for each element: plot, characters, problems, resolution, setting, and title and reflect. Bring them home to keep!</p>
<p><b>Interview a friend!</b>            Write 10 questions for a friend to answer about their book. Write down the answers. Then, read each other your favorite parts.             You need to be together!</p>	<p><b>Make a paper plate presentation</b>            for your story. You need have 1 circle. The first circle is your name, book title, author, and a picture. The other 4 circles must have a picture and a summary sentence.             Then you will present to the class.</p>	<p><b>Write a long and make up a book!</b>            that shows an event from your story. The story must be at least half a page long, and you need to draw pictures and list the story steps. Then, perform it for a friend!</p>
