

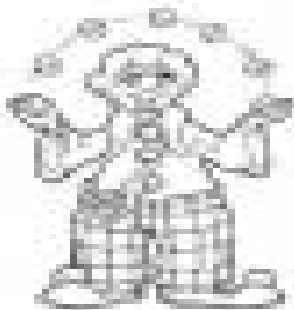
Contractions and Pronouns
