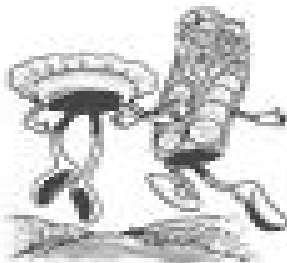


Read these two poems out loud.
