

Genesis 4-11

1. Read Genesis 4 and answer the following questions.

- a. List below the generations that are included completely or in part in Genesis 4-11.

Second Generation – Enoshites
Third Generation – Human Government

- b. What is the subject of chapter 4? (BNC p. 25)

The spread of a godless society

- c. What were the occupations of Cain and Abel? (4:2,3)

Abel was a shepherd, Cain was a farmer

- d. What is the "way of Cain"? Read Jude 11 and BNC p. 24.

A path of faith that shows Abel to enjoy all God's blessing with the righteous, to maintain order, to think of responsibility, and to refuse to accept God's punishment.

- e. The BNC makes an interesting comparison between Eve's sin and Cain's. What is it? (BNC p. 24, 4:3,7)

Cain would not be talked out of sin - even by God. He was too angry. Eve had to be talked into her sin by Satan.

2. Read Genesis 5 and answer the following questions.

- a. What phrase is repeated on 5, 8, 11, 14, 17, 20, 27, 30 and who was the exception (4-20, 24)

"and he died"

Enoch was the exception. If there isn't say "and he died", it says, "And he was not, for God took him."

- b. What is the meaning of the name "Noah" and how does it relate to the chapters to follow? (BNC p. 26)

NOAH – "comfort – to rest or to be down" Noah would comfort those under the curse.

3. Read Genesis 6-8 and answer the following questions.
