

**How to use a bilingual dictionary.**

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You need to know the alphabetical order very well to be able to find the words in the dictionary quickly.

(2) quilt, quiet, given, quick, quick

(3) knight, knock, know, know, knit

(4) thought, through, throat, thought, through

(5) west, whring, whole, wrong, wrought
