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Usage

Retrieve the can opener from its storage area.						
Place counter top can opener into the counter top housing for use						
Carefully place the can on the counter under the can opener.						
Firmly press the cutting blade into the can						
Turn the knob on the can opener to rotate the can and open the lid in a clockwise motion						
Once the lid has been cut almost completely (leave a ¼ inch gap) so that the metal does not fall into the food; remove the can lid carefully and dispose into the garbage						
Lifting the can opener away from the open can, remove the can to the side						
Wipe the can opener blade with a clean cloth						
Remove the can opener from the counter top housing and put it in the proper storage area for the next usage.						

Blade Rotation

If there is a nick in the blade facing the frame of the can opener, you will need to rotate the blade.						
Unscrew the blade holder (using applicable screw driver) and remove the blade (using mesh glove) and then turn the blade around.						
After you reverse the blade, place it back into the blade holder and tighten the screw up so that the blade doesn't fall out
