

Non-singular

1. Nominative (the verb)
 - Present singular: The boy **is** sleeping.
2. Plural (the nominative or subject complement)
 - Present plural: They **are** sleeping.
 - Present singular past tense: She **was** sleeping.
 - Present plural past tense: They **were** sleeping.
 - Present singular imperative: **Sleep!**

Verbs

1. Direct address
 - You **are** late!

Adjectives

1. CE (complement)
 - The girl **is** beautiful.
2. CE (predicate)
 - The girl **is** beautiful.
3. CE (the whole position)
 - The girl **is** beautiful.
4. CE (predicate and CE)
 - The girl **is** beautiful.
