The Nortons often go on excursions on Sunday.

Today it is Sunday. The Nortons want to go to a lake near Nottingham. They want to rent a boat\*. They want to sail\* on the lake. Then\* they want to go to a restaurant. They have lunch at the restaurant. After\* lunch Peggy and James want a cup of coffee. The children don't want coffee. They want an ice cream. They like ice cream. Then they go home. Peggy drives. She usually drives. James doesn't like to drive.

At home Peggy and James watch television and Janet and Phil play video games. The children go to bed at 9 o'clock. Their parents\* go to bed at midnight. They don't work tomorrow. Tomorrow they stay at home and rest.
