

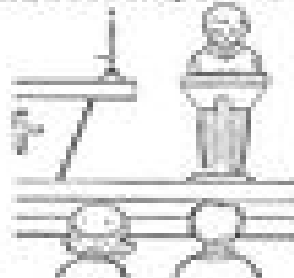
ORDER OF THE MASS THE LORD SPEAKS

The Priest comes to and greets the people in the name of Jesus.

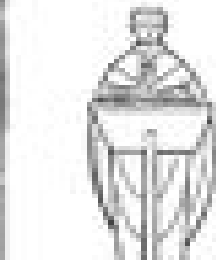


When the priest is the Priest says the readings to God who is present in His Word.

The people raise their prayers to the Lord.

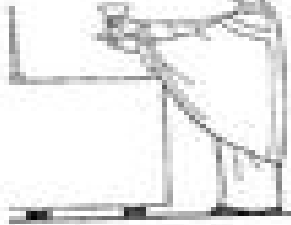
PRESENTATION OF THE OFFERTORY

Ministers bring to the altar the Bread and Wine, each of us presents to God his or her daily work.



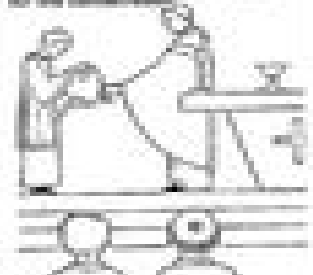
PRESENTATION OF THE OFFERTORY

The Priest washes his hands as a symbol of purity in preparation for the celebration of the Eucharist.



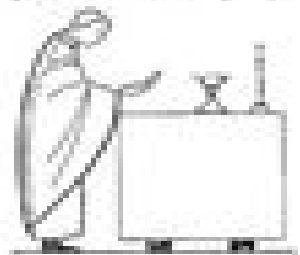
THE PREFACE

CONSECRATION OF THE BREAD

The priest offers to Jesus his or her Body, Blood, and Soul, and says: This is my Body.



CONSECRATION OF THE WINE

The priest offers to Jesus his or her Body, Blood, and Soul, and says: This is my Blood.



All of you who drink from this chalice share the Blood of Christ, the Blood of the New and everlasting covenant, which he shed for you and for all. Drink from this cup to remember the Blood of the New Covenant.

THE GREAT AGNUS

We give our thanks to all that has been done for us by the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.



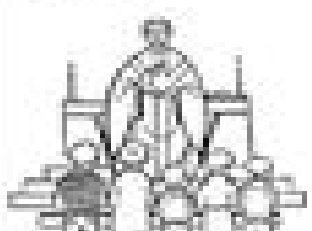
THE LORD'S PRAYER
