### Completing Complex Sentences Worksheet

A complex sentence contains an independent clause and a dependent clause. An independent clause is a complete sentence that can stand on its own. A dependent clause is not a complete sentence for it cannot stand on its own.

Dependent clauses start with subordinating conjunctions such as (so, because, since, before, even though, after, although, wherever, while etc..)
