


For example, the Sierra Nevada range is located in western North America (western US and southern Canada). The surface is about 70% water and 30% land. This land is divided (elevated) into 7 mountain ranges, of which the Pacific Coast Range, the Colorado Rockies, the Sierras, and the Sierra Nevada. The highest peak in the country (20,320') lies just outside the state of California in the Sierra Nevada range.
