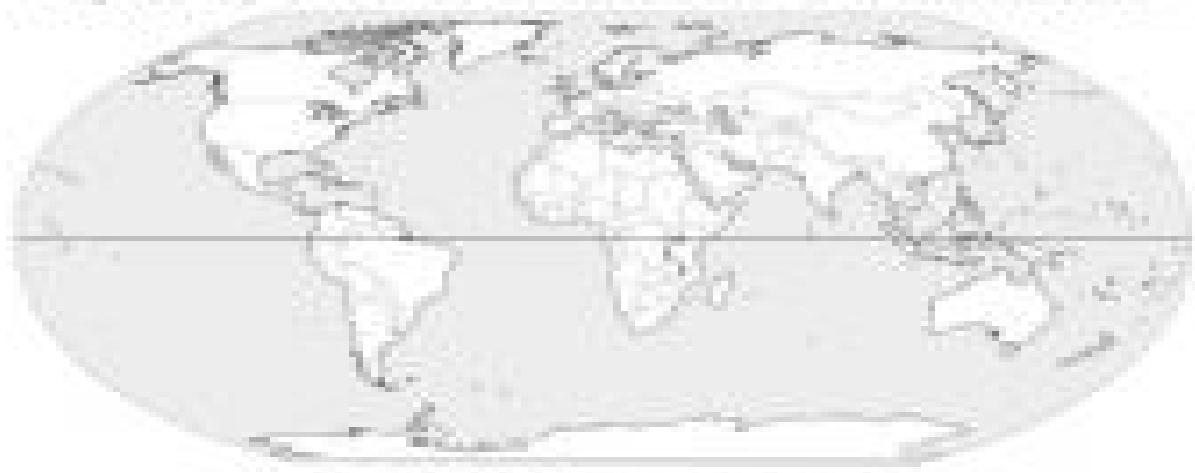


From 1960, the **Great Lakes** flow is because the **lakes** (200 of the Earth is mostly water. The surface is about 70% water and 30% land. The land is divided (200) into 7 continents: **Asia, North America, South America, Europe, Antarctica, and Australia.** The water is divided into 4 oceans: the **Pacific Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Indian Ocean, and the Arctic Ocean.** The **Equator** is a imaginary (200) line that divides the Earth in half. It separates **two** tropical latitudes: **North, South, East, West** longitude.
