

Embedded Questions

An **embedded question** is a question that is included in another sentence.

Question	Embedded Question
When is your teacher's class?	Could you tell me when your teacher is?
What time is it?	Do you know what time it is?
When is she going home?	I don't know when she is going home.

Notice the shift in the verb when you reform an **embedded question**:

- When is your teacher's class?
Could you tell me when your teacher is?
- What time is it?
Do you know what time it is?

Use **embedded questions** only, not **question** only, with **embedded questions**.

Embedded Question	Beginning of main clause	Question Word	Subject	Verb	ending
When is the next class?	Could you tell me	when	the next class	is	?
What time is the meeting today?	Do you know	what	the meeting	is	?
When is the meeting today?	Can you tell me	when	the meeting	is	?
How much do these shoes cost?	Could you tell me	how much	these shoes	cost	are they?
