#### SIOP Lesson Plan/Nov. 2005 Elementary (No grade specified)

Topic: Book Talk

Content Objective: The learners will speak and write (use) English to share their thoughts and feelings.

**Language Objective**: The learners will choose text that interests them and share it with their peers through Book Talk.

Key Vocabulary: Why do you like\_\_\_\_\_?

I like \_\_\_\_\_\_ because \_\_\_\_?

favorite/opinion/ interest
title/author/illustrator

Materials: vocabulary cards/tying English to native language, leveled texts, poster paper, crayons and markers, pictures showing emotion

#### **Higher Order Questions:**

- What is your opinion of the text? Why?
- On a scale of 1 to 5, how would you rate this book? (1=poor, 5=excellent)
- To whom would you recommend the book?

### Link to Experience:

Activate prior knowledge based on interest through self-selection.

### Links to Learning:

- Review fact/opinion
- Where do we find title, author's and illustrator's names?
- Sentence starters-5 W's

# **Student Activities:**

- Graph results from book ratings
- Scaffolding
  - 1. Model self selection and book talk (books leveled for student selection.
  - 2. Guided speaking with sentence starters (Think, Pair, Share)
  - 3. Independent reading.

# Grouping:

- Whole group presentation
- Partners-Think, Share, Pair
- Independent-Reading
- Small groups to practice presentation

## Review/Assessment:

- Presentation
- Revisit graph, summarize results
