How To Draw 3 Dimensional Letters: Method 3 - Vanishing Point

Letters on a page look flat. That is called "2 dimensional".

You can give your letters depth by drawing the sides of the letter, as well as the front. Even though you're still drawing just lines on a piece of paper, your letters will have the "illusion" of depth. They will look "3 dimensional", like they can jump off the paper at you. This is called drawing in "perspective".

In a "3 dimensional" drawing, a "vanishing point" is a point at which all imaginary lines of "perspective" converge. You can place a vanishing point any where on your drawing that you wish.
