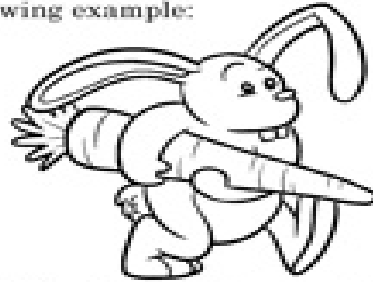
Analogies

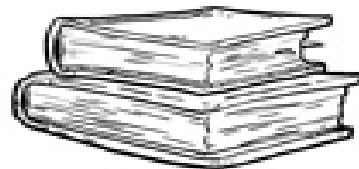
