### **1: Balance**

Balance is the visual weight in an artwork. You know an artwork is balanced when a single section does not over dominate the rest. If you cut an artwork up into sections, each section should have something going on in it. Symmetrical balance is when the same amount of things are on one side of the art work as the other side. Asymmetrical balance is when two sides of an artwork are different, but seem visually balanced because of such things as color and shapes.
