<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The President is in charge of this branch of government. The head of this branch is the commander in chief of our armed forces. This branch represents the country in talks with other countries. This branch is in charge of the day-to-day affairs of the government. The person who heads this branch can be elected to serve only two 4 year terms. This branch carries out the law of the country. The head of this branch can veto a bill passed by Congress. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This branch decides whether the country's laws are fair. It is the branch that decides cases about the Constitution or the country's laws. This branch decides cases between citizens of different states. The nine members of this branch are named by the President but voted by the Senate. The members of this branch can serve for life. This branch decides cases about treaties with other countries. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> It is the branch that makes laws to rule basic. This branch is in charge of making an army and a navy. This branch controls trade with other countries. It is the branch in charge of making the country's laws. This branch consists of two houses: the Senate and the House of Representatives. It is the branch in charge of having money printed and coined. It is the branch that has the power to declare war.
