

# Italian Musical Terms

## Speed (or tempo) (from slow to fast)

adagio	slow
largo	slow and broad
lento	slow
andante	at a moderate walking speed
moderato	at a moderate pace
allegretto	fairly fast
allegro	fast and lively
vivace	fast and lively
presto	very fast

## Changes of Speed

accel. or accelerando	gradually getting faster
rall. or rallentando	gradually getting slower
rit. or ritardando	gradually getting slower
rit. or ritenuto	held back (slower at once)
a tempo	back to the previous speed

## Dynamics (from quiet to loud)

pp (pianissimo)	very soft
p (piano)	softly
mp (mezzo piano)	moderately soft
mf (mezzo forte)	moderately loud
f (forte)	loud
ff (fortissimo)	very loud

## Changes in Dynamics

cresc. (or crescendo)	gradually getting louder
decresc. (or decrescendo)	gradually getting quieter
dim. (or diminuendo)	gradually getting quieter

## Other useful words

legato	smoothly
cantabile	in a singing style
da capo (or D.C.)	from the beginning
dal segno (or D.S.)	from the sign 
staccato	short and detached
fine	the end
