

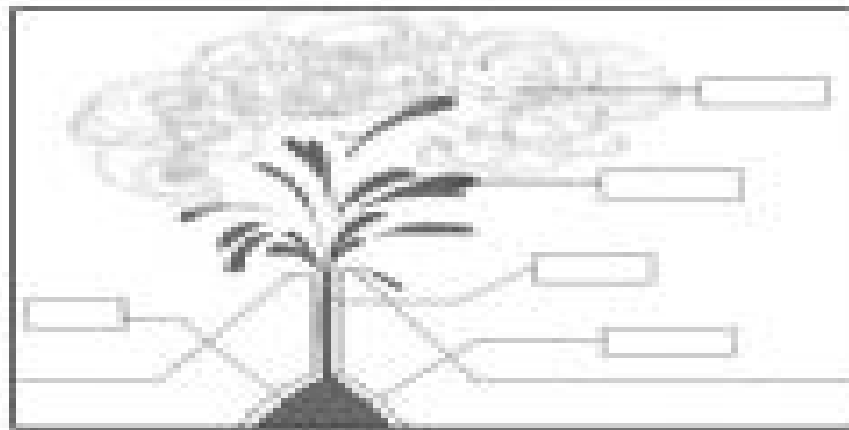
Stems and Root Systems

1. Read the passage below and fill in gaps with the given words.

Plants have a thick support stem to the ground and a central chamber to fill of sap. The outer of the stem is called bark. Most of the stem, however, are composed of soft tissue called wood.

When a stem is cut, a ring of cells called cambium forms and then the stem gets thicker, forming a ring of secondary xylem and a ring of secondary phloem.
